Joyful: Annunciation (Lk 1:26-38), Visitation (Lk 1:39-56), Nativity (Lk 2:1-21), Presentation (Lk 2:22-38), finding Jesus in the Temple (Lk 2:41-52) (Mondays and Saturday)

Luminous: Baptism in the River Jordan (Mt 3:13-16), Wedding Feast at Cana (Jn 2:1-11), Proclamation of the Kingdom Mk 1:14-15), Transfiguration (Mt 17:1-8), Institution of the Eucharist (Mt 26) (Thursdays)

Sorrowful: Agony in the Garden (Mt 26:36-56), Scourging at the Pillar (Mt 27:26), Crowning of Thorns (Mt 27:27-31), Carrying the Cross (Mt 27:32), Crucifixion (Mt 27:33-56) (Tuesdays and Fridays)

Glorious: Resurrection (Jn 20:1-29), Ascension (Lk 24:36-53), Descent of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:1-41), Assumption, Coronation (Wednesdays and Sundays)
